Dentists like Drs. Nikita Pastagia and Ranu Sinha understand that oral care goes beyond focusing on a patient's mouth. While the connection can get overlooked, a person's overall well-being often affects their oral health.

"As doctors, we need to see a patient's underlying issue and understand their fear. We need to treat them holistically," says Dr. Pastagia, a partner at Shrewsbury Dental Group, in Shrewsbury, New Jersey.

Dental professionals address patients' emergency needs and discomfort, centering on pain, bleeding and decay. Dr. Pastagia and the staff at Shrewsbury Dental Group treat the patient more holistically. "Patients come to the [dentist] office for the pain, and their expectation is to get that pain taken care of," Dr. Pastagia says. Traditional care can help remedy the immediate issue, but it seldom provides an end to the cause. "We have to resolve the main problem."

Instead of concentrating on just one tooth or a specific problem area, Dr. Pastagia discusses with patients their overall health in regard to their oral care and creates a treatment plan customized to help manage their individual needs. The result: Dramatic improvements in patients' health, smile and confidence.






### Sample UFCW ID cards to help identify members





# Use the correct CDT codes for patients being treated for orthodontics

Frequently, the American Dental Association CDT code D8680 — orthodontic retention — is being used incorrectly in claims submitted for removing dental appliances, such as retainers, from non-orthodontic patients. Orthodontic treatments are coded differently than non-orthodontic treatments.

Use CDT code D8680 — orthodontic retention — only when submitting claims for patients undergoing orthodontic treatment. This claim covers appliance or bracket removal and constructing and replacing retainers.

When submitting claims for services on patients with no history of orthodontic treatment, select one of the following codes that apply:

- D8210 removable appliance therapy
- D8220 fixed appliance therapy
